

# Ice Hockey Queensland Inc Policy Document

## Role and Responsibilities

**Position:** Coaching Director

Reporting to: IHQ Executive Committee

Responsible for: To provide leadership and guidance to all coaches and players in IHQ

Duties:

- Work with IHQ and the various IHQ coaches to develop and implement programs for various ages and levels of play from state representative teams to the “Come and Try” Program
- Work with coaches to identify strengths and weaknesses (needs assessments) to enhance a coaches’ capabilities and improve the level of coaching standards for IHQ players
- Initiate and facilitate coaching clinics and seminars at various periods during the year to accredit prospective coaches
- Instigate the provision of providing annual assessments on players to further develop players and assist IHQ and state selection purposes
- Be heavily involved in the selection of State representative players on all teams
- Assist IHQ in the marketing and promotion of ice hockey to schools and communities groups through the “Come and Try” Program
- In cooperation with and approval and support from IHQ, develop strategies to retain IHQ members and attract new members
- Utilize various media, advertising and workshops to raise awareness of the sport of ice hockey
- Support and develop IHQ players on opportunities in developing their skills in local, national and international competitions and events through various mechanisms
- To deliver improved participation opportunities and initiatives to the sport and active recreation industry
- To improve regional, rural, and remote communities access to sport and active recreation industry
- To improve products and services to local and regional level organizations throughout Queensland
- To encourage research and development projects that respond to the emerging issues relating to participation, obesity and building active and healthy communities
- Must be a registered member of IHQ
