Role and Responsibilities

Position: Referee Association Representative (Zebras)

Reporting to: President of IHQ
IHA Referee In Chief

Responsible for: Ensuring that the IHQ has an adequate number of qualified officials and is aware of Ice Hockey Australia's direction with respect to officiating.

Duties:

Ensure the IHQ has an adequate number of qualified on-ice officials by:

- Recruiting and assisting new officials to become certified
- Develop and carry out a mentoring program for new officials
- Facilitate the initial, and ongoing training of all on ice officials
- Facilitating the regular supervision of officials throughout the year
- Ensuring that officials are fully familiar with officiating stands and the current rule emphasis
- Participating in Tribunals as required
- Ensure that IHQ is aware of Referee's Association concerns and needs and vice versa
- Understand and implement IHA automatic suspension list
- Nominate officials for National tournaments
- Ensure courses of a suitable level are held to provide growth in the number of on ice officials
- Implement systems for reporting of infractions so that they can be dealt with efficiently
- Act as liaison between IHQ and IHA Referee In Chief
- Must be a registered member of IHQ
